The minimum charter duration is 4 nights. There is no maximum charter duration, provided that it does not clash with any pre-existing booking.

Child Policy and Single Supplements

On our Yacht Charters, you pay for the whole yacht privately so there is NO single supplement for single cabins or special children prices. You pay for the yacht regardless of the ages of the guests or number of guests on board. Max 8 guests.

There is no minimum age for a child to be on board, but parents must take responsibility for their own children as crew cannot be responsible for babysitting small children. On board there are life vests; however we reiterate parents must be ultimately responsible for their children.

All bookings are subject to our standard terms and conditions.

Payment Terms

Cancellation Fee Terms

30 % non-fundable deposit on booking.

St Lazarus Banks Charter - Start Pemba / End Pemba

START DAY

Arrive in Pemba. Board yacht. Depart St Lazarus Banks

ON CHARTER

Fishing at St Lazarus Banks

LAST DAY

Charter ends in Pemba in time for departure to airport

This is an example itinerary and is subject to change due to weather conditions, guests interests while on charter and operational requirements.

St Lazarus Banks Fishing Charters

Day One depart Pemba approx. 16.00

Fly from JHB to Pemba (flight not included). Flights arrive between 13.30 and 14.30

You will be met at Pemba airport. Transfer to where the yacht is moored. After a safety briefing, we raise anchor and head north into the Quirimbas Archipelago or depending on conditions, and guests interests we head directly for St Lazarus Banks. It is a 10 to 12-hour cruise to St Lazarus Banks from Pemba. We should be on the banks by around 3 am approx to begin your fishing adventure

On Charter Days

Fishing St Lazarus Banks and if guests wish the Quirimbas Archipelago too.

Last day (approx. 10.00 am depart the yacht)

Return to Pemba in the morning and transfer to the Pemba airport. Return from Pemba to JHB

St Lazarus Banks

St Lazarus Bank is situated in the Mozambique channel about 70 nautical miles east of the northern Mozambique coast. This shallow seamount has almost 60 square kilometres of shallow topography and has exceptional physical and biological characteristics that make it a biodiversity hotspot and a paradise for yellow fin tuna, dogtooth tuna and marlin.

Although the St Lazarus Bank is known as an atoll the reefs do not reach the surface and back-reef lagoons, typical for atolls, are lacking. The central, table-like platform of the seamount reaches from six to about 60 m deep on the margins and rapidly drops to around 2000 m on all sides. Expect an abundance of fish and birds feasting on an ocean of delicacies, especially during August to December when it is Mantis Shrimp season and billions of these crustaceans rise to the surface to mate every year.

Large examples of predatory fish species can be found in these waters and includes snappers, jacks and this is one of the few areas left on earth where pelagic fish can still be found in large quantities. Manta rays, sharks (around eight species to date), whale sharks, huge schools of feeding barracuda, many species of king fish, red snappers, green and hawksbill turtles, pods of humpback dolphins and humpbacked whales (in season) frequent these waters.





St Lazarus Banks

A trip to St Lazarus Bank is the ultimate holiday for experienced divers and fishermen. Here the fish are so abundant and monstrous that using rapala or tackle less than 50 lb is asking for trouble. It is not a surprise that this area is known as “Legendary St Lazarus Bank” and you could be one of the few who not only talk and dream about fishing or diving here, but can experience something that few people have experienced before.

Each year in August / September through to December is Mantis Shrimp season along the East African Coast from Pemba to just South of Dar Es Salaam. Billions of these crustaceans rise to the surface to mate every year. This abundance of an easy nutritious meal attracts schools of baitfish that attract Giant Yellowfin Tuna from as little 20 Kg's up to as much as a 100 Kg, Giant size Dogtooth Tuna of up to 75Kg's, GT's of up to 50 Kg's, Wahoo of up to 40 Kg's and Barracuda of up to 38 Kg's together with schools of a wide variety of other Game Fish and reef fish; too many to mention.

These feeding frenzied gamefish are being caught off the surface and down at 20 m's on trolling lipped lures or on casting flies, spoons or plugs while drifting. You almost can't miss!!!

The only way to get to this frenzy is by yacht so that you can live right over the best fishing area and fish to your hearts content.

QUIRIMBAS ARCHIPELAGO YACHT CHARTERS

The Quirimbas Archipelago consists of over 30 islands, stretching north to south along the coastline of Northern Mozambique. The Quirimbas National Park encompasses 11 of the islands including Ibo Island (nominated for World Heritage), Quilalea, Matemo, Rolas and various others. Your cruise will take in most, if not all of these main islands, plus, time permitting many other islands like Mogundula and Medjumbe and up to Vamizi island and out to St Lazarus Banks.

The islands stretch some 200 miles along one of the most unexplored stretches of coastline in the world. The Quirimbas Archipelago is without doubt one of the best yacht charter destinations in the world. Most islands are uninhabited and all are blessed with white sandy beaches surrounded by a tropical Indian Ocean and a marine environment that has remained virtually unexplored.

The Maxim 400 Fly Bridge Power Catamaran is in good condition and is the perfect platform for island hopping adventure charters, fishing and scuba diving.

There are 2 separate bathrooms on-board which all guests and crew share.

Her main saloon and outside cockpit area have a comfortable cushioned seating area and the galley is well equipped with a 4 Burner propane oven and stove, hot and cold water, fridge and separate freezer.

There is a stereo and music system for guests, but there is no TV on board!

She is well equipped with a range of fishing gear & tackle, mask, snorkels & fins and inflatable towable doughnuts.

FLIGHTS

QUIRIMBAS ARCHIPELAGO

For the **Quirimbas** in Mozambique, International flights fly into and out of **Pemba**, with SA Airlink or LAM

SA Airlink JHB to Pemba

Flights 5 times a week direct to Pemba.

Approx R9000 pp return. Mon, Wed, Thur, Fri, Sat

LAM Air JHB to Pemba via Maputo

Flights 4 times a week via Maputo (1hr stop)

Approx R 6500 pp return. Mon, Wed, Thur, Sun

Different Islands

Charters can on request start and/or end at Ibo Island, Medjumbe Island, Quilalea Island or Vamizi Island.

For Vamizi Island there will be an empty leg delivery fee of 50% of the per night charter rate.

TANZANIA - ZANZIBAR, MAFIA, PEMBA ARCHIPELAGOS

For the **Tanzania** region, International flights fly into and out of Zanzibar or Dar Es Salaam. Flights are daily and there are various airlines that fly, including Mango Airlines and SAA.

Different Islands

Charters can on request start and/or end at Zanzibar, Mafia, Pemba Islands or Dar Es Salaam.

For Mafia and Pemba Islands there will be an empty leg delivery fee of 50% of the per night charter rate.

NB. You will need to add on the necessary light aircraft flights and transfers between these islands (if needed) and we can manage this for you. For flight prices please discuss this with us further as the flight costs will depend on where you are coming from or going to. Contact us for further details.

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

PEMBA - MOZAMBIQUE

We will meet you at Pemba airport and transfer you to our yacht in Pemba bay.

20 USD per person return

TANZANIA - ZANZIBAR, MAFIA, PEMBA ARCHIPELAGOS

You will be met at either Dar es Salaam, Zanzibar, Mafia or Pemba airports and transferred by road to where ever you are meeting the yacht. These costs are not included and will be specific to your requirements. We will quote you as needed to meet your requirements.

Departure & Arrival Times

- Standard Check In - Embarkation is 2pm (middle to late afternoon)
- Standard Check Out - Disembarkation is 10 am (mid-morning)
- Times for Embarkation & Disembarkation are subject to the specifics of the charter and can be tailored to suit the cruise itinerary.
