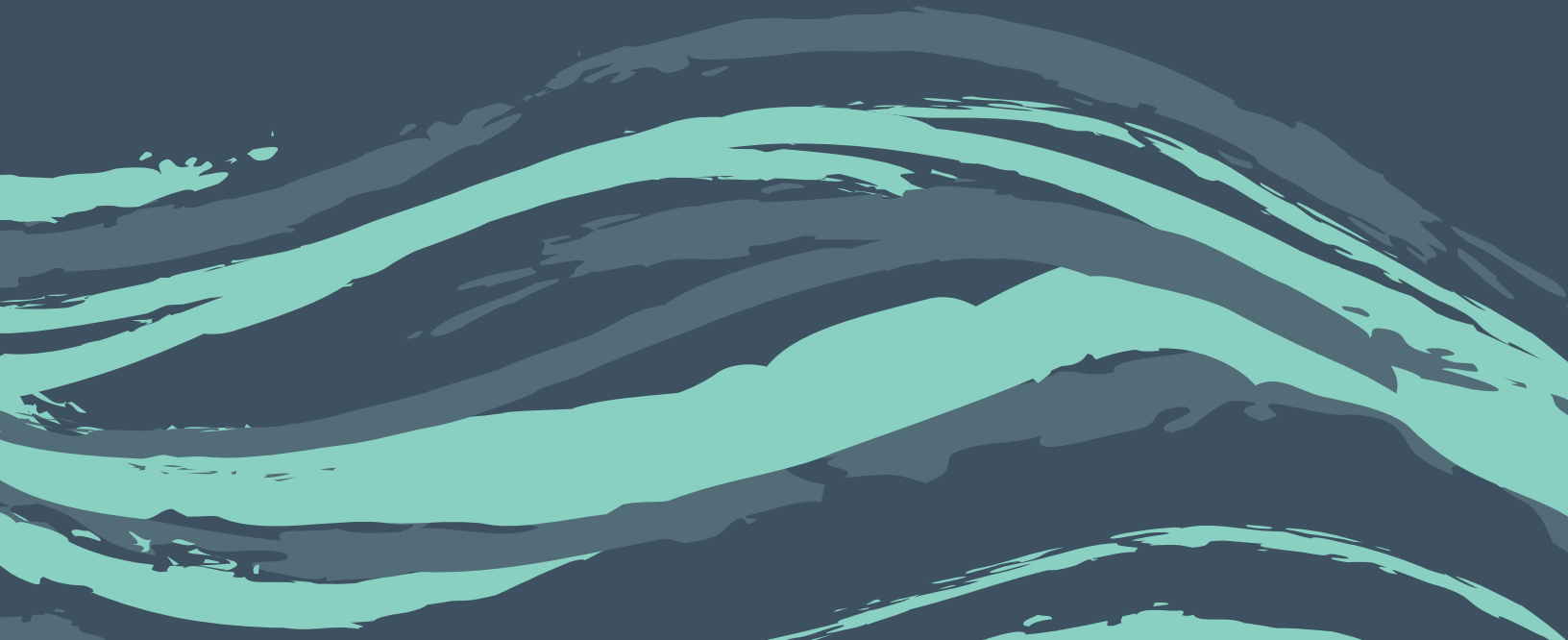

# ITINERARY

## DAY 1-4 / QUIRIMBAS ISLAND CRUISE

### Day 1. Ibo Island Lodge.

Fly from Jhb to Pemba with either LAM or SAA.. You will be met by staff at Pemba airport and transfer to the light aircraft terminal for the 35 min flight over the southern islands to Ibo Island. On arrival you will be met and transfer across the island by vehicle to Ibo Island Lodge. Enjoy a refreshing non-alcoholic cocktail while your luggage is loaded onto the yacht. You will then board. following a safety briefing and yacht orientation we will set sail. Our first stop for the night will be Matemo Island

**Day 2.** Matemo /Rolas Island in the morning. Cruise to Mogundula Island in the afternoon. Over night at Mogundula

**Day 3.** Mogundunla Island. We will spend the day and night at Mogundula Island. Its our **own** private island.

**Day 4.** Cruise up to Medjumbe Island to explore the area before heading south to Ibo Island. Depending what time we arrive, we can go ashore and enjoy the facilities at the lodge, take a swim in the pool or have sundowner drinks at the room top bar. It is possible to do a cultural and history tour of Ibo. It has been nominated for world heritage status and is a truly fascinating island. Depending on the tides it may be possible to have dinner at Ibo Island Lodge rather than on the yacht.

### Day 5.

The yacht will sail to Quilalea Island where guests will disembark for the next part of their adventure.

The yacht has snorkeling gear, fishing gear, kayaks, Stand up Paddle board, various inflatable water toys. So the days will be spent relaxing and enjoying the islands and water sports and taking it easy, so we will not be racing from one island to the next. This will be a relaxed cruise and we will try to meet the guests preferences on what they want to do as much as possible.

## **Day 4 Medjumbe Island and Ibo Island**

Depart early for Medjumbe Island. Unfortunately it is private so we can go shore, but there is a smaller island to the west and great snorkelling and shallow clear seas.

We will then head south on the outside channel to Ibo. We will through a fishing line out and see what we can catch.

At Ibo we can go ashore and do a cultural and history tour of Ibo. It has been nominated for world heritage status and is a truly fascinating island.

Afterwards take a swim in the lodge pool or have sundowner drinks at the room top bar. Depending on the tides it may be possible to have dinner at Ibo Island Lodge rather than on the yacht.

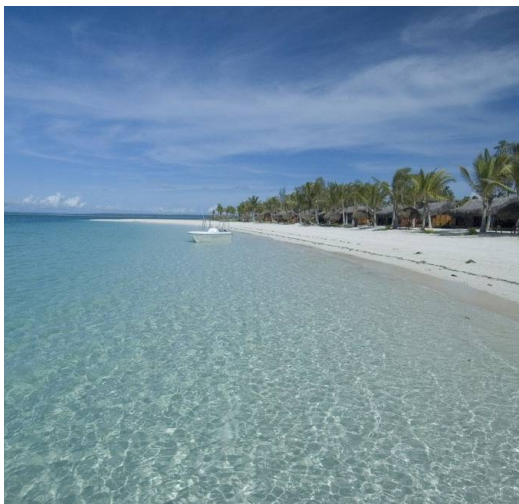


## QUIRIMBAS ARCHIPELAGO YACHT CHARTERS

The Quirimbas Archipelago consists of over 30 islands, stretching north to south along the coastline of Northern Mozambique. The Quirimbas National Park encompasses 11 of the islands including Ibo Island (nominated for World Heritage), Quilalea, Matemo, Rolas and various others. Your cruise will take in most, if not all of these main islands, plus, time permitting many other islands like Mogundula and Medjumbe and up to Vamizi island and out to St Lazarus Banks.

The islands stretch some 200 miles along one of the most unexplored stretches of coastline in the world. The Quirimbas Archipelago is without doubt one of the best yacht charter destinations in the world. Most islands are uninhabited and all are blessed with white sandy beaches surrounded by a tropical Indian Ocean and a marine environment that has remained virtually unexplored.
